



## Post Wings Training Programs Joining Instructions

Congratulations on being selected to conduct post wings training at Southport. These instructions, along with the CFTS General Joining Instructions, are designed to give you information to get you smoothly started.

Your trg will be conducted using a combination of ground based FTDs and airborne instruction. Instruction will be provided by both civilian and DND personnel; KF Aero or CHL will teach ground school and instruct in the FTDs while DND will teach all airborne lessons. All personnel administration is conducted through Client Services while training administration is through your Course Director on behalf of the Stds Flt Comd.

Your course will consist of one of the following:

- ME Conversion - 30 training days
  - 10 days ground school / admin; and
  - 20 flight training events (9 FTD and 11 airborne).
- ME FIC – 38 training days in addition to ME Conv
  - 5 days of additional ground school; and
  - 31 flight training events (5 FTD and 26 airborne).
- ME Refresher – 14 training days
  - 2 days ground school; and
  - 12 flight training events (5 FTD and 7 airborne).
- RW FIC
  - B206 SE – 71 training days
    - 13 days ground school; and
    - 68 flight training events (58 dual, 8 mutual and 2 solo).
  - B412CF TE – 87 training days
    - 18 days of ground school; and
    - 57 flight training events (13 FTD and 44 airborne - 40 dual and 4 mutual)
- RW Refresher – 21 training days
  - 10 Days ground school; and
  - 13 flight training events (5 FTD and 8 airborne).

On Day One of your course please plan to arrive at the HBB by 0745 and report to Client Services, they will advise you on which classroom to go to. Dress of the day for your training is flight suit.
